

Linden City Council Minutes

June 1, 2015

The city council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hutchins at 7:00 PM. Finnell, Rector, Norton and Daggett were present. Smith was absent.

Motion to approve the last month's agenda and minutes was made by Daggett, and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett, and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the bills to be paid was made by Norton, and seconded by Daggett. Motion carried.

Fire chief report was given by Larry Idle. This month the department will clean the fire station. Battery was replaced in the truck.

Maintenance report was given by Leon Daggett. With all the rain, there has been a lot of mowing to do. Paint was purchased to paint the curbs.

Daggett made the motion to hire part time help to test tanks with Roy Root. Rector seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Permits are needed when putting up fences; Norton asked about neighboring property having a permit for a fence that is going up. Mayor will follow up with property owner.

Roy Root informed the council that people have not been using the recycling dumpster properly; dumping non-recyclables and leaving boxes and bags when dumpster is full.

Posting of the city ordinance for loose dogs will be placed on the bulletins, fines will be enforced.

The city will hire Mosquito Control of Iowa again this year to do the spraying. Clerk will look into what a smoker would cost, to do the spraying.

Dave Hutchins brought a flag (donated by his sister) that has the names of the victims from September 11th World Trade Center. It will be on display for Linden Daze.
