Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett, and seconded by Epley. All in favor; Motion carried.

Clerk Report- spoke to the council about residents having chickens in town. Council may change ordinance to allow 6 or less hens, but no roosters.

Wendy Lemke asked the council for a donation of \$250.00 for the Christmas party. Epley made the motion to donate \$250.00, Daggett seconded the motion. Motion carried.
