

Linden City Council Minutes

January 4, 2016

The city council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hutchins at 7:00 PM. The mayor swore in the new candidates Doug Epley and Roy Root. Roll call was taken; Finnell, Epley, Rector, and Root were present.

Motion to approve the agenda and minutes was made by Rector, and seconded by Epley. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Rector, and seconded by Root. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the bills was made by Epley and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Fire chief report was given by the fire chief Larry Idle. Reported the water gallons of the water tower. Brakes were locked on the truck and Korey looked at it and filled it with fluid.

Maintenance report was given by Roy Root. Drains were cleaned out, Christmas lights taken down, and snow removal.

The Dallas Country representative for the emergency communication division did not come to the meeting. Talk about the tower has been tabled.

Ed Meacham asked the council about the flooding from Main St to the end of Dallas St. The council discussed where the storm sewer lines run and what work Accujet did. After Accujet put the new line in and flushed the lines, water was running good. But the storm sewer cannot handle heavy rain. The council will budget for storm sewer work when the funds are available.

June Rector would like to know who is responsible to clear the sidewalk on the triangle near the bike trail. The city will take care of it.

Cargo Market is closing, so the city will have to start using Heartland.
