August 7, 2017

The city council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hutchins at 7:00 PM. Finnell, Rector, Root, Daggett, and Epley were present.

Motion to accept the bills to be paid was made by Daggett, and seconded by Epley. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda and minutes was made by Daggett, and seconded by Epley. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett, and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Report- one call last month, 6 people showed up for training, and there will be a free class in October and a couple people are going.

Maintenance Report- mowing and picking up brush, and the mower is going back to Van Wall to get oil leak fixed.

Public notice will be drawn up for the sale of city property (Norton property).

The local option sales tax ballot language will read, 20% for Library Services, 20% for Fire Dept, 20% for debt relief, and 40% for street and capital expenditures. Motion was made by Daggett and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Joe and Bill Smith spoke to the council about joining the alley to 101 W Dallas. The council will have the city attorney look at the land agreement.
