

Linden City Council Minutes

June 5, 2017

The city council meeting was called to order by Mayor Hutchins at 7:00 PM. Finnell, Rector, Root, Daggett, and Epley were present.

Boys from scouts would like to paint cross walks and curbs to have community service hours for Boy Scouts. The City will purchase the paint.

Motion to accept the bills to be paid was made by Daggett, and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda and minutes was made by Daggett, and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett, and seconded by Rector. Motion carried.

Maintenance report- mowing, trimming and picking up brush this month.

28E agreement in regards to the farm to market extensions with Dallas County was tabled.

Robert Greenway spoke to the council about local option sales tax. Only 5 cities in Dallas County collect local option sales tax. A signature drive (1900 signatures needed) to get it on the ballot. Deadline is August 1st. Residents will pay 1% on each utility. Linden will receive more money back than the amount paid in; approx. \$120-140/per person paid monthly.

Joe Smith spoke about the land behind the post office; the land is owned by county conservation.

Open forum- more sewer tanks need pumped, (Finnell) the well by the tower should be checked.
