

Linden City Council Minutes

August 6, 2018

The city council meeting was called to order by Mayor at Basquin at 7:00 PM. Lemke, Basquin, Daggett, and Epley were present. Root resigned.

Bills to be paid are as follows: Xenia- \$48.90, MidAmerican- \$11.08, Jensen Sanitation \$32.00, Heartland Coop- \$192.62, City of Redfield- \$20.00, Alliant- \$944.40

Motion to accept the bills to be paid was made by Basquin and seconded by Daggett. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda and minutes was made by Basquin and seconded by Daggett. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett and seconded by Epley. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Report- No Calls. The sale of the van is pending. New building ideas were discussed, starting with a financial plan.

Maintenance Report- there was a sewer line break; has been fixed.

Open Forum- Roy Root resigned and the city will appoint a new council member; a special meeting on August 20<sup>th</sup>. Roy has agreed to continue reading the meter at the lagoon. Rene Smith spoke on behalf of the library; the library has started a GoFundMe online and raised almost \$6000.00. Rene requested that the city goes in on a new air conditioner for the building. Wendy made the motion for the city to go in on a new air conditioner, Leon seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Lagoon- DJ will need access to the pumps, he will take one full set of everything and put on his truck. We received the new permit, 3 new lab tests, drawdowns are the same. Will spray this fall and will need to hire the guy with the bush hog mower. By December 30<sup>th</sup>, every tank will need the levels checked and recorded.
