The city council meeting was called to order by the Mayor Ken Basquin at 7:00 PM. Roll call: Root, Daggett, Epley, Basquin, and Lemke were present.

Motion to accept the bills to be paid was made by Daggett and seconded by Root. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda and minutes was made by Root and seconded by Daggett. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett, and seconded by Epley. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Report- No calls last month.

Maintenance Report- The lagoon meter is working; Roy is reading the meter daily.

Clerk Report- The council needs to begin the FY18 budget.

Navin Bhramdat wants to build a shop on property, council will need to consider rezoning area as commercial property. Bhramdat will fill out building permit paperwork and submit to council/planning and zoning.

Jason Burger holds a tax lien on the Findley property (210 North St.) he asked the city if they would be interested in the property. The council tabled it until further discussion.

Pam Basquin is getting an estimate from Windstream for a phone line (answering service) for the city.

A grant was written and submitted for the fire department for the purchase of new fire truck.

The budget was discussed; tabled until next month. Pam Basquin will meet with the clerk before the next meeting to work on a budget to present to the council.
