

Linden City Council Minutes

April 2, 18

The city council meeting was called to order by the Mayor Ken Basquin at 7:00 PM. Roll call: Root, Daggett, Epley, and Basquin, were present. Lemke was absent.

Public Hearing for the FY19 budget was held. Motion to approve 2019 City Budget Resolution #266 was made by Pam Basquin and seconded by Leon Daggett. Motion carried.

Motion to accept the bills to be paid was made by Daggett and seconded by Basquin. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the agenda and minutes was made by Basquin and seconded by Daggett. Motion carried.

Motion to approve the financial/budget reports was made by Daggett and seconded by Basquin. Motion carried.

Fire Chief Report- There were no calls last month. The van is on craigslist and flyers will be posted. First responders were in town.

Maintenance Report- patched potholes on several streets, ½ hour of plowing snow, picked up limbs, and replaced sign on Short Street. Work on the pumps at 110 and 107 Dallas was done.

The cost of new pumps will be charged to the homeowners when grease or other materials are found. The city is required to pump tanks once every five years, if tanks need pumped more often or there is abuse of the septic those costs will be charged to homeowner as well.

The maps of the septic are wrong; there are no valves in town. Going forward, the maintenance crew will have to mark where things are.

The sewer ordinance and the city ordinance will be reviewed and combined in a book for all council members.

Tabled the phone for city hall.
